## World Skills Competitions

Founded in 1950, WorldSkills is the global hub for skills excellence and development. This event brings youth, industries, and educators together to give youth the chance to compete, experience, and learn how to become the best in their skill of choice. From the traditional trades to multi-skilled technology careers in the industry and service sectors, supported by partners, industries, governments, volunteers, and educational institutions, WorldSkills vision is to improve the world through the power of skills. It has 75 Member countries and regions, all working with youth, educators, governments, and industries to help prepare the workforce and talent of today for the jobs of the future.

World Skills Competitions are held every 2 years. India started participating in the event from 2011. Since then the event has taken place at London, Leipzig, Sao Paulo and Abu Dhabi. In 2019 the competitions are scheduled at Russia.

WorldSkills India is an initiative of the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Government of India. NSDC has been leading the country's participation at WorldSkills International competitions since 2011.

The key objectives of WorldSkills India are to:

- Promulgate skills in society to motivate the youth to pursue vocational education.
- Champion skills and learning for work through local, regional, national and international skills competitions
- Create partnership network comprising of government, industry, academic partners, VET institutions, trade associations and youth to promote skills
- Establish long-term association with WorldSkills International and other WorldSkills member countries

This event is like Olympics, where teams of skilled people in various sectors participate and compete with each other. Overall, competitions are held in 51 skills. One participant from each country per sector is nominated for the competitions. To select the participants, the NSDC spearheads the task of organizing regional level competitions across India in various sectors. Thereafter, state level competitions take place and then final candidates are selected for the WSC.

At the event, the candidates, so selected after the National Competition, compete with their counterparts from the entire world. Indian participants, so far, have shown wonderful results, whereby, medals and medallions have been won by them.

For 2019 Russia, the country is preparing and all the stakeholders have started their best efforts so that Indian participants win medals and make the country proud.

AMH SSC is coordinating the Fashion category of the competition and is in the process of coordinating with all stakeholders, including leading Fashion institutions and State Govts so that the best candidate, ultimately, is selected who will represent the country in Russia 2019.

## Arvind to set up mega apparel facility in Gujarat

Arvind Limited, one of India's largest textile to retail conglomerates, is going to set up a first-of-its-kind Rs. 300 crore mega apparel facility in the state of Gujarat. Following a recent announcement by the Government of Gujarat (GOG) with regards to the Garments & Apparel Policy 2017, the Ahmedabad based company has signed a memorandum of understanding with GOG. Once fully operational, the Rs. 300 crore project in Dahegam will employ more than 10,000 people and produce over 24 million garments annually. "Gujarat has always been a leader in textile manufacturing. The Gujarat apparel policy will have a far-reaching impact on helping the state forward integrate into apparel manufacturing and develop vertical solutions for global brands. This progressive policy from the Gujarat government will go a long way in making Gujarat a hub for the end-to-end textile and apparel value chain," said Punit Lalbhai, executive director of Arvind.

"We plan to commence commercial production in the fourth quarter of 2018 and we plan to create 10,000 jobs, a majority of which will be women. We are excited to support the Gujarat Apparel policy whose aim is to create 1,00,000 jobs in Gujarat. We are confident that with such a conducive policy Gujarat will emerge as a major destination for garmenting," said Kulin Lalbhai, also executive director of Arvind.

## Textile Ministry seeks more Funds for Powerlooms

The Rs. 33.27 crore would be in the form of supplementary demand for grants, the minister said, adding that of the Rs. 126.76 crore allocated for 2017-18, Rs. 83.08 crore has already been spent till now. The textiles ministry, which had allocated a sum of Rs 126.76 crore for the Power Tex India scheme, is planning to seek an additional Rs. 33.27 crore for 2017-18, textile minister Smriti Irani said earlier this week in the Rajya Sabha. The Rs. 33.27 crore would be in the form of supplementary demand for grants, the minister said, adding that of the Rs. 126.76 crore allocated for 2017-18, Rs. 83.08 crore has already been spent till now. The information came in response to a question by R Vaithilingam of AIADMK, who also sought to know if the government is considering to enhance the capital subsidy for powerlooms in the country.

Irani said that there was no proposal as yet on enhancing the capital subsidy from the present 10% to 30 per cent. Irani also said that in the period 2017-18, 48 yarn bank proposals and 118 group work shed proposals have been approved. "Only two applications for group work sheds are pending," the minister added. The ministry of textiles announced the yarn bank scheme under Power Tex India with an objective of providing interest free corpus fund to special purpose vehicles or consortiums to enable them to purchase yarn at wholesale rate and give the yarn at a reasonable price to small weavers.

## Skill India to train 20,000 youth in textile sector

About 20,000 youth across the country would be skilled by 2020 in apparel, made-ups and home furnishing sectors in collaboration with textile major Arvind Ltd, said Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Minister Ananthkumar Hegde.

Arvind Ltd (formerly Arvind Mills) is the flagship company of the Ahmedabad-based Lalbhai Group and manufactures cotton shirting, denim, knits and fabrics. As the second largest employment generator in the country, the textile sector has huge demand for skilled candidates. The job roles, aligned to the National Skills Qualifications Framework, encompass training of candidates for three to six months. The skills are being provided at Arvind's nine training centres across the state. "The youth will be trained to become specialised sewing machine operator, quality check executive in sewing line, packer, pressman and washing machine operator," said Hegde. The training is open to all skill seekers, especially the unemployed youth in 18-35 years age group. "Corporate India can be a major contributor to this nation-building exercise. The industry can utilise its expertise and provide relevant training to the youth in accordance with the demands," he said.

## Government announces measures to boost garment exports

The government has also doubled the rates for incentives under an export promotion scheme MEIS to 4 per cent for readymade garments and made-ups.

Union Textiles Minister Smriti Irani said post-GST rates for remission of state levies/taxes and Enhanced Merchandise Exports from India Scheme (MEIS) rates will boost exports of garments and made-ups. Garment exporters' body AEPC said the increase in MEIS rates will help in the fulfilment of orders for the Christmas festival as it will help in unblocking the blocked capital. In a release, the textiles ministry said post-GST rates of RoSL are up to a maximum of 1.70 per cent for cotton garments, 1.25 per cent for MMF, silk and woolen garments and 1.48 per cent for apparel of blends.

The ministry said the notification of post-GST RoSL rates for rebate of state levies/taxes is in pursuance of the decision of the government to boost exports and employment generation in the labour intensive textiles and apparel sector. The Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) has enhanced rates for garments and made-ups to 4 per cent of value of exports from 2 per cent under MEIS. New MEIS rates are effective from November 1.
